

Students (aside from positive cases) will be encouraged to attend school if they do not have any symptoms.

Please keep in mind the definition of close contacts as outlined on the SA Health website: www.sahealth.sa.gov.au/wps/wcm/connect/public+content/sa+health+internet/conditions/ infectious+diseases/covid-19/testing+and+tracing/close+contacts. There has been some confusion amongst families, so we may need to clarify details if we believe students should be in quarantine rather than continuing to attend school. We appreciate the ever-changing rules may be hard to comprehend, but please be assured our reminders, our questions and these measures are in place to uphold individual and community health.
